Help spread the message about road safety in your community by entering the Road Safety Song Competition. There are great prizes to be won!

The Competition

Indigenous bands are encouraged to write a road safety song and perform it at the Barunga Battle of the Bands during the Barunga Festival on Sunday 12 June 2011.

There are great prizes for the winners

- \$2000 for 1st prize
- \$1000 for 2nd prize
- \$500 for best school entry.

Why should bands enter the competition?

- To help improve road safety awareness for Indigenous people
- To win a prize
- To get your band known.

The Song

The song can be any style of music, including rock, blues, rap, traditional or any other form. It should include road safety messages, such as:

- Always wear your seat belts
- Never drink and drive
- Pedestrians watch out for cars
- Licenced drivers are safe drivers
- Don't ride in the back of utes
- Don't put too many people in the car.

Conditions

All competition entrants acknowledge that selected songs from this competition may be used by the Northern Territory Government in road safety educational and promotional campaigns. These songs are intended for use in different media.

Bands may re-enter their song in the 2011 competition if they have not won in the past. It is hoped the band will build this song into their regular performances.
